
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

LETTER FROM **BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

At Ramallah Friends School we cultivate community in the face of adversity. This yearbook is a beautiful testament to our faith in community and resolve to live life abundantly.

Great challenges no doubt faced both the proud farming people of Ramallah and the Quaker people of faith who founded Ramallah Friends School in 1869. Yet today, 153 years later, the school stands strong. The challenges have shifted, but the grit to cultivate an open-minded school community remains.

In 1869, Ramallah must have been a busy village in the hill region of Palestine, fortunate as it is that vibrant community cannot be taken for today, to have a view of the Mediterranean Sea on a clear day. The people of Ramallah were in The Search For Common Ground, "Community rugged farmers who grew grapes, figs, wheat, cannot feed for long on itself; it can only flourish and olives. Yet the difficulty of life, poverty, oppression, and lack of opportunity would have made building a school a formidable task. Today, a grinding military occupation in Palestine denies freedom to our school students. staff, and families. A pandemic and climate crisis cast an ominous shadow. What is perhaps most unnerving is that injustice is normalized. Freedom seems ever more distant.

Yet at Ramallah Friends School we guietly, steadfastly cultivate community despite all odds. Amidst a moment of adversity, the great African American writer James Baldwin cautioned not to normalize injustice in his essay. Nothing Personal (1964):

For nothing is fixed, forever and forever and forever, it is not fixed; the earth is always shifting, the light is always changing, the sea does not cease to grind down rock. Generations do not cease to be born, and we are responsible to them because we are the only witnesses they have.

The sea rises, the light fails, lovers cling to each other, and children cling to us. The moment we cease to hold each other, the moment we break faith with one another, the sea engulfs us and the light goes out.

Here Baldwin calls us to keep the horizon of freedom as our focus, however distant it may seem. He broadens our scope outside of ordinary bounds of human vision and calls us to "hold each other" in a community of faith.

Moreover Howard Thurman, the African American philosopher and minister, warned granted. It must be cultivated. He wrote in 1971 where always the boundaries are giving way to the coming of others from beyond them unknown and undiscovered brothers."

Let us keep these insights close as we explore the pages of this amazing community. We are called to seek the horizon of freedom and equality and must continually cultivate community to reach it.

It is a gift to serve the Quaker school community of Ramallah Friends School, composed of a people who demand to live life in abundance. May this yearbook and the ones to follow stand as a demonstration of how we carry the spirit of abundant life with us through the world.

RFS is where I grew up. It practically runs it meant until I worked at RFS. Here memory is through my veins now. At the end of seven years of service as the upper school principal, I cannot help but recognize that this phase of my life and RFS's history has ended, and that we are all as a community moving up into a new era. Let me recognize the validity of the last seven years and their priceless value to me, for I have learned immensely from colleagues, parents and most importantly students. When I was a student, my beliefs, knowledge and skills were shaped at RFS. I discovered my knack for chemistry, and my passion for writing as a young teenager. But then twenty years later, RFS proved once again that it has a lot to teach me as an adult and educator. My alma mater, forever and always.

Because human memory can be short, it is important to recognize the achievements of the last seven years at the upper school and to thank the incredible team that made them possible. From the increased success rate in the Diploma Program, to the highest number of Ivy league acceptances, to university scholarships closing in on \$10M, to the increased IBDP average, and the successful evaluation of both the MYP (twice) and the DP (once); all of these and more belong to the RFS community. They are the fruit born out of teamwork and a strong sense of belonging. Schools are made of people and when people work together they achieve.

I once read that memory is the act of the past in the present. I didn't quite understand what

not only a passive act of remembering the past. but rather an essential ingredient in shaping the school's present and future. Education is accumulation, and it is only the achievements and mistakes of the past that led us to where we are today as a community.

At the end of every year, I sit to write this letter, and I struggle. I struggle because at the heart of what we do, at its very core, is love. And how do you quantify love, restrict it to a specific word count? Our days are filled with it; sometimes it is happy and carefree; other times it is tough. But, in the end it is indeed Love that brings us together as a community. I always tell students that even when disciplinary measures are needed, they stem out of love. And when discussions get heated between teachers, or between parents, that heat is also generated out of love. It is because we care for the school, its legacy, its existence here in Palestine that we passionately defend it, serve it and continue to be members of it.

So at the end of this year, as I make my 'graceful exit', and as we all move up, not out, I urge you to keep the heat, and preserve the love so that many more generations of Palestinians have the chance to be part of this community.
