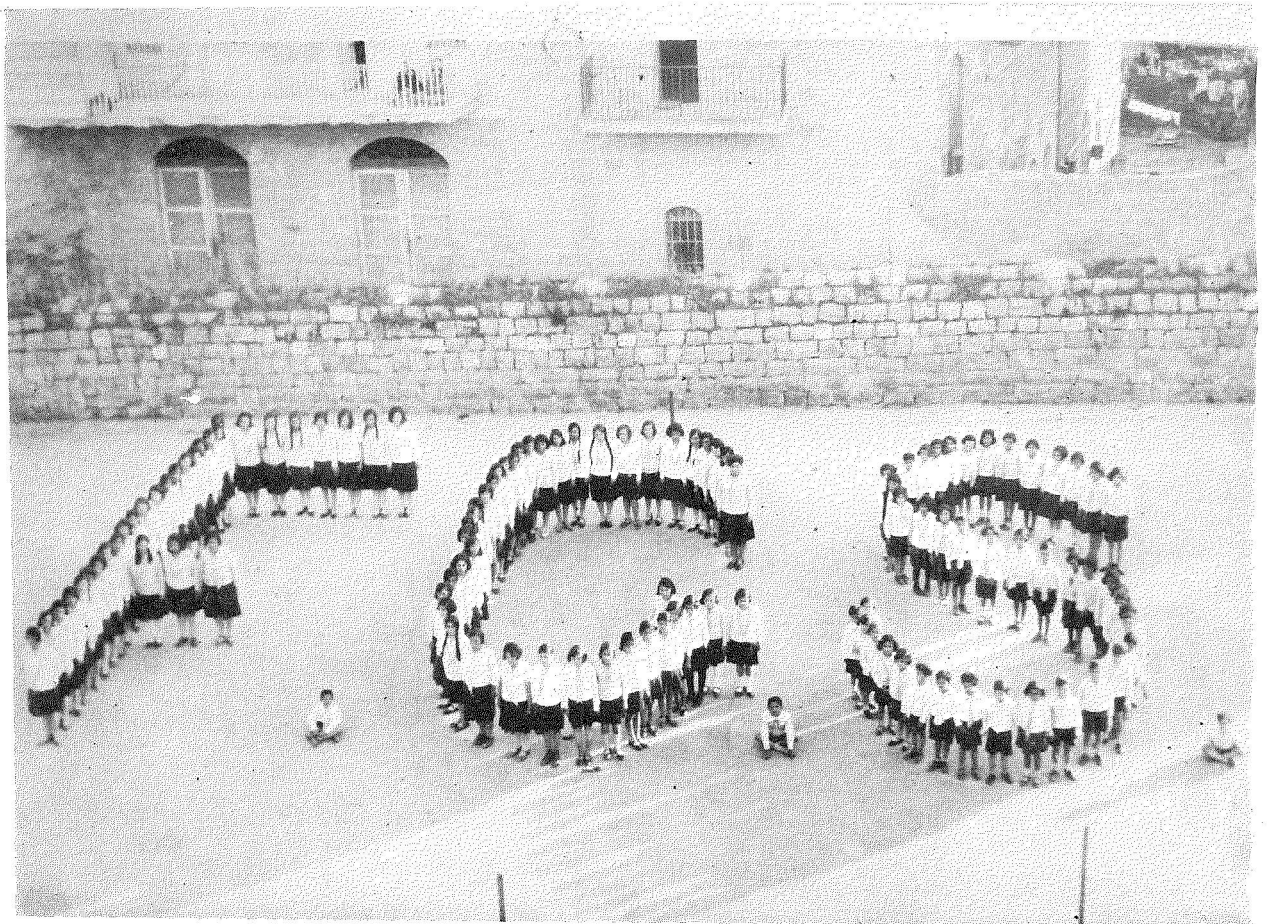
Listen, friends, and you shall hear,

Friends Girls School in Ramallah.

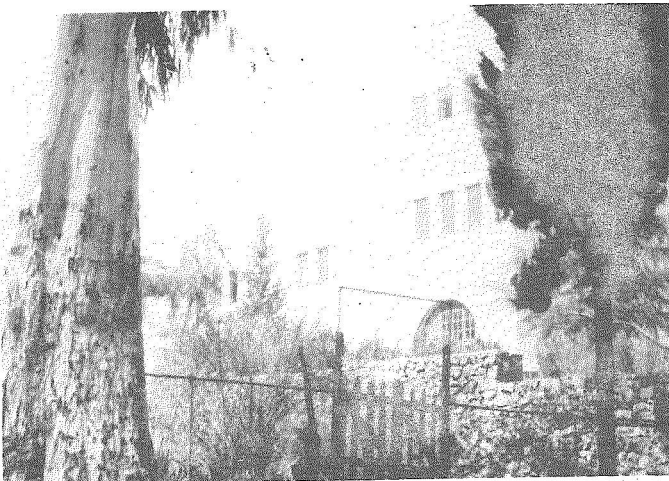
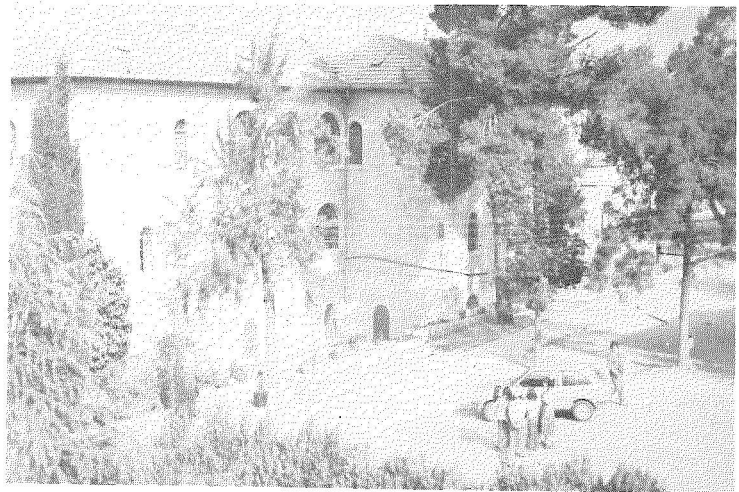


LOOK AROUND

1883-1925

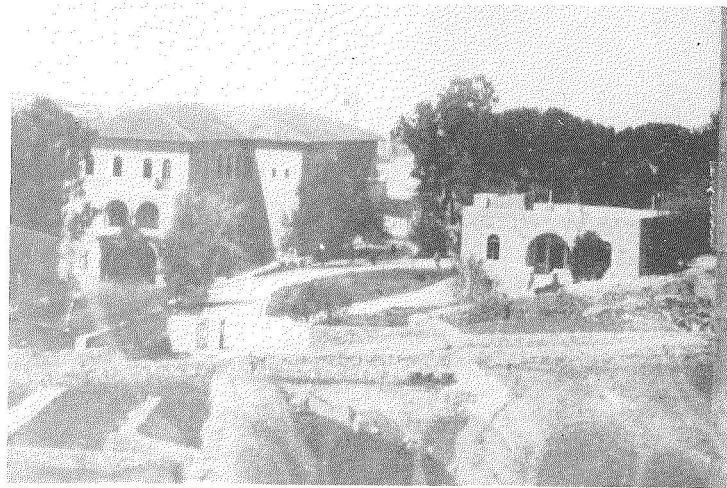

Remember this moment in time, For it had passed.

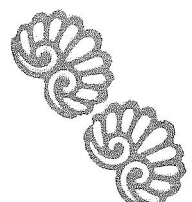
