The Student Association was established in the year 1981. It was formed to bring more unity among the students. There are several ways in which the Association approaches getting this unity. It tries to improve the academic standards of every F.G.S. student. It also tries to gain more cooperation and friendship between the students of neighboring schools and those of F.G.S. A better social, cultural, artistic, and physical interest in their heritage and school is encouraged in the students. This helps them to relate to other people and give assistance when it is needed.

There are certain clubs which branch-off from the main body of the Association, which also help unify the school. The Cultural Committee helps students become more aware of their Palestinian background. It does this by having lectures, posting bulletins, and planning activities together with other schools. The Social Committee creates unity in the students by staging gatherings and parties. These affairs, on occasion, are connected with other schools in order to help students from different places be able to better relate to each other. The Art Committee acquaints the students with their Palestinian heritage. It teaches traditional dances, songs, and folklore from this land. It helps them to appreciate their heritage and make it an important part of their lives. The P.E. Committee arranges games and sports activities which further the spectators' enjoyment as well as the participants' physical ability and endurance.

Each of these committees work together to back up the school and create cooperation between both teachers and students. With this being the first year of the Association's existance, it has had many rough-edges as well as effectively

being an asset to the school.

The Student Lounge was finally opened, and now gives the student-body a refreshed sense of importance and belonging. The Debka groups have shown great ability and bring pride to the entire school. The lectures and bulletins have helped inform the school of what is happening, what has happened, and what can happen in the future.

There are countless other ideas and accomplishments which the Association has strived torfulfill this year. Not all have yet been completed or materialized but the efforts have only begun. The idea of unity and the goal of understanding, being with, and sharing with the people of this great land, during hard and good times, is a goal which has been successfully achieved at F.G.S. during this year, "1981".
