Success cannot be fully appreciated unless the meaning of the word failure is totally and fully understood.

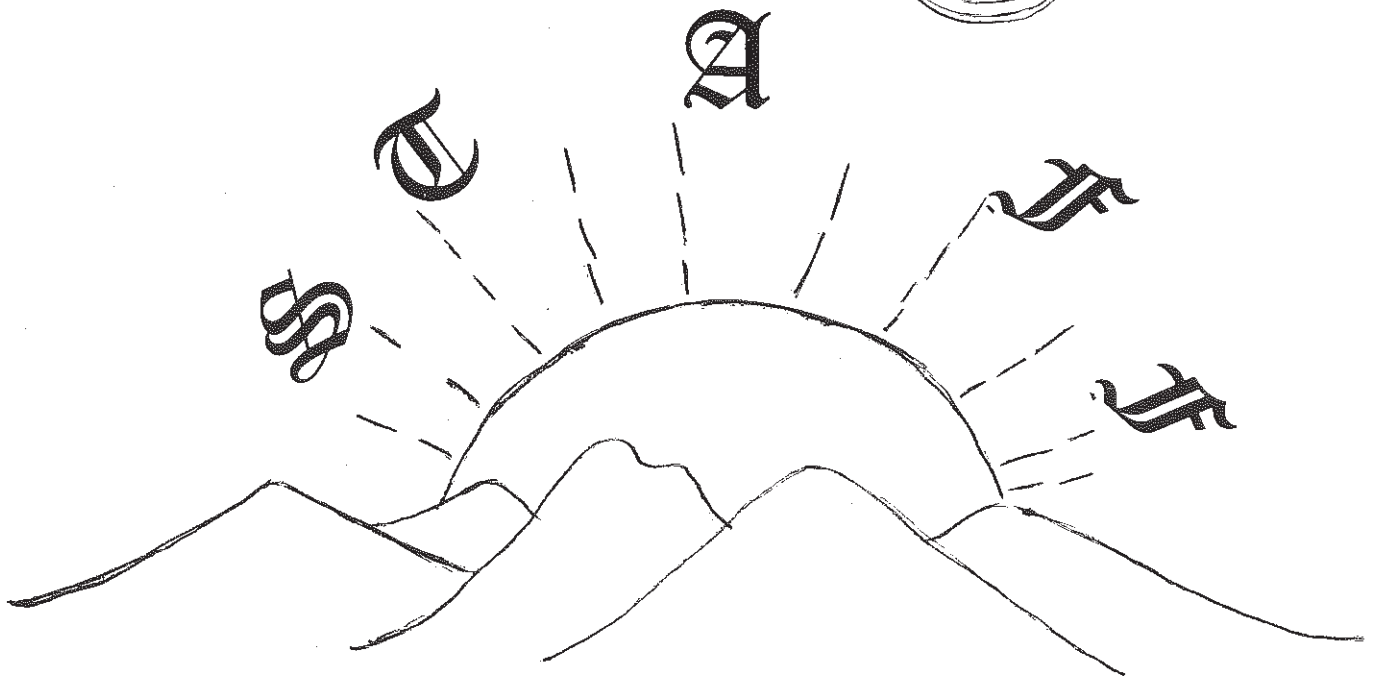
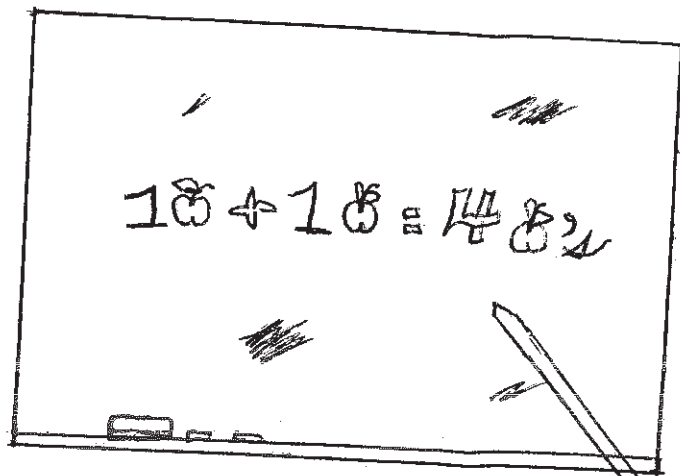

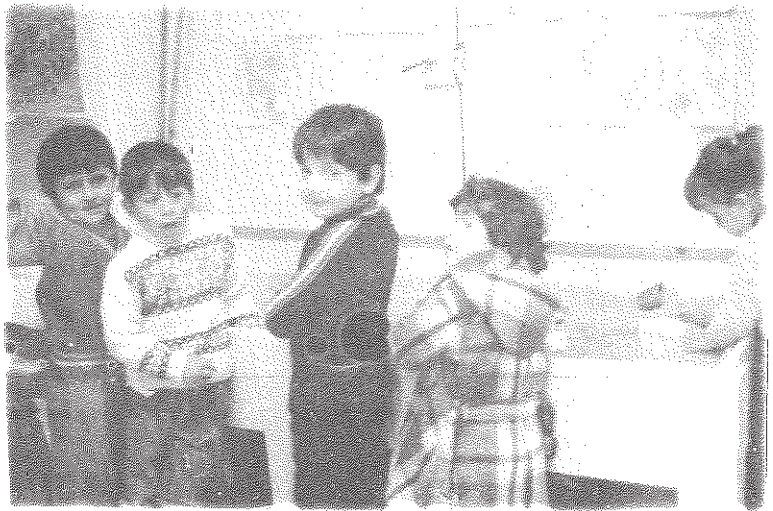
NURSERY
