Israel Prevents Lion From Rescuing Androcles

The first act of the lighthearted comedy *Androcles and the Lion* was presented at the Nuzha/El-Hakawati Theater in East Jerusalem April 23.

The hundreds of children and parents in attendance were not, however, allowed to see the final act. During the intermission, Israeli authorities arrived. They posted closure notices on the theater doors and ordered the management to clear the auditorium in five minutes. The young actresses from the Friends Girls School in Ramallah were allowed to take a quick, final bow in front of a cheering, but stunned and disappointed audience. As soon as everyone was out of the building, the doors were locked.

Androcles and the Lion, presented in Arabic by secondary students from the FGS, had been in rehearsal for months. The presentation was the high point in the drama department's work this year, coming at the end of a series of presentations at FGS and neighboring schools. "I can't believe this is happening," one young actress said as she left the theater. "We were prohibited from performing the play at one school because of a curfew, and now we've been closed here."

Small children asked their teachers what would happen to Androcles. At the end of the first act, Androcles, the slave who befriended the lion, had been captured by his evil master and led off under a net. The audience was left in suspense. The final act would have revealed that the good deed done by Androcles was repaid. The lion would have saved his friend, freeing him from slavery. But the closure at 3:45 pm kept the students and adults from celebrating the slave's freedom.

There were practical difficulties connected with the closure.

Some children had been brought to the theater by parents who promised to return at 4:30 pm after the play was over. Other adults tried to make arrangements for the stranded children.

The closure notice on the door was written in Hebrew. People translating it said the theater was closed from 4 pm to 12 midnight on April 23, because an illegal political meeting was prohibited. No one knew or could ascertain whether *Androcles and the Lion* was considered illegal; whether the closure was directed at FGS or another unknown group; or whether the Israeli authorities had mistakenly arrived while the school play was still in progress. When this reporter tried to ask these questions of the three Israeli officials, they walked away and refused to answer.

Shortly before the end of the first act, Androcles had pulled a thorn from the lion's paw. The lion then dusted off a rock with his tail and offered Androcles a seat. With a beaming smile, the slave exclaimed, "Human beings have always treated me harshly; but you, an animal, are kind to me." The play, based on an ancient fable, teaches that a good deed done for others will be repaid.

The theatre was fully packed with school children. At least 300 of them were between the ages of seven and 12.

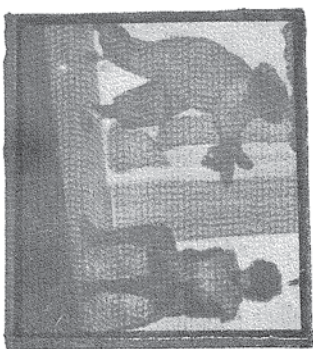
Everybody was enjoying the play and waiting for the second act to start when the manager of the Hakawati appeared on stage to announce that he had just received orders to empty the hall because the theatre was to be closed by the authorities in

10 minutes. He urged the children to remain calm and leave two by two with their escorts. There were children who were to be picked up by their parents at the end of the show and had to stay outside waiting until they came.

I wished those who gave the orders were at the door to see the children leaving the hall with eyes full of tears of disappointment and fear. My six-year-old son could not understand. I could not ease his bewilderment, as I could not understand myself. But I wonder: What harm would have been caused if the school play had been allowed to continue?

"The Palestinians, especially the young are suffering . . . I do not have a government to protect me, or a state to call my own. My country is occupied by Israel. There are soldiers walking and marching in the streets. They are not there to defend me. I have a friend whose sister was shot because she was with her friends striking. You have freedom of speech and I don't. You can help me," said FGS Prep Three student Nadia Hussary to a San Antonio, Texas audience.

"It was great to express one's feelings about the Palestinian situation, as here one can't do that," said Urieb El Aref, a Secondary Three FGS student.

Last fall two FGS students were invited to participate in two North American peace tours -- the US-based "Children of War" and "The International Youth for Peace and Justice Tour" which visited Canadian cities and towns. Each tour lasted a month and involved young people, from areas where conflict or war is a part of daily life, talking to peers living in North America. Palestine, Israel, South Africa, El Salvador and Guatemala were among the countries represented in the tours.

The aim of the tours was to promote world peace through frank and honest discussions of students' experiences as well as possible alternatives to war.

Nadia and Urieb both felt that in addition to being able to express their own beliefs and experiences, and thus dispel the stereotypical images of Palestinians portrayed in the media, they became more aware of other people's pain and struggles.

Urieb, who previously had never travelled outside of Palestine, said, "I always thought that Palestinians were unique in their suffering, but after my trip I realize there are problems all over the world, like in Nicaragua, Guatemala, and for Native Americans. This doesn't depress me, in fact it gives me hope. I realize we [the people struggling for human rights] are the majority and one day perhaps we will unite and all be free."
