

Address of the Principal

It pleases and makes me feel proud as we near the end of the 1993-1994 school year to give an overview of some of our accomplishments at the Friends Girls School. It has been a year brimming with activities and full of giving on various levels.

## 1. Renovation

The main building on campus, in existence since 1885, was renovated during the summer vacation last year, hence the school year began with new vast rooms for computers, music, art, the library and a science lab for the primary levels as well as Prep I. The new area has enhanced these various resource rooms and added a much more suitable environment for learning.

# 2. Academic Achievements

A number of accomplishments have marked this school year, of which we will mention here:

- (i) teaching computer science to the 5th and 6th grades whereby two students share each terminal and reinforce each other's understanding of the subject;
- (ii) a continuation of the French as a foreign language program in conjunction with the French Consulate for the students of the 4th, 5th and 6th grades, to be expanded to the 7th grade curriculum in the 1994-1995 academic year;
- (iii) initiating numerous brass, string and wind instruments for the music department and thus opening the doors to an FGS concert band.

# 3. Extracurricular Activities

We students and teachers are proud of the hard work put into the various activities that complement our academic achievements. The numerous extracurricular activities at the FGS include:

- (i) The **FGS** Club with its various undertakings including gymnastics, ceramics, computers, choir, basketball, music, debkah, karate and drama in both Arabic and French. These activities along with other sports made "Open Day" a great success this year along with one play in Arabic, another in French and the music program;
- (ii) The Science Fair that included experiments performed by the students at the elementary level was a grand success and wonderful learning experience, as well as it being just plain fun to set up and present projects to visitors
- (iii) The Art Exhibition which included various subjects taught to the student during the school year:
- (iv) A visit by a Finnish clown to the kindergarten and first grades thoroughly entertained the children;
- (v) Teaching the students health and personal hygiene through a series of lectures given by a parent, **Dr. Taroub Harb Faramond** was a reflection of the cooperation encouraged between the school and parents;
- (vi) Cooperation of students with the school librarian in publishing three editions of the publication "Friends of the Library" that include educational items developed and presented by the students themselves:
- (vii) Revival of the *Passports to Reading* program in the library in conjunction with Tamer Institute for Community Education;
- (viii) Work on the strengthening of ties between the students and the community where they visited charities as a part of religion and ethics classes. These visits greatly afffected the students who were permitted to see parts of their community that are not always evident to them. Students also worked on raising funds for the White Gifts Program through which 41 impoverished

- families benefitted. The **YMCA** Choir was invited to the school where it performed before Christmas and the proceeds of the successful event were donated to the White Gifts:
- (ix) Cultural contests and plays were regular events during the Monday morning assembly meeting known as "Chapel" throughout the school year.
- (x) Students went on an enjoyed numerous fun and educational trips to religious and cultural sights, getting to better know their country.

# 4. Upgrading Skills

The FGS has always sought to upgrade the skills of the teachers in order to keep them informed of the latest developments in teaching and education. Development activities for teachers include:

- (i) sending one of the FGS English teachers to the annual TESOL (Teachers of English as a Second Language) Convention in Baltimore, USA with funds raised here in Palestine;
- (ii) sending the French language teacher to a conference in France on children's issues;
- (iii) holding a workshop in October whereby professors from local universities discussed educational issues with our teachers;
- (iv) having 4 FGS teacher participate in a workshop for private school teachers to be held in August sponsored by the Nahda Society and Bethlehem University.

## 5. Yearbook

I would like to mention here that with the end of the school year we will lose one of the most active teachers and a dear friend who has contributed 4 years of her life to the two Ramallah Friends Schools. **KT Ockels** was responsible not only for teaching various levels of English and history at the Schools but for making the FGS yearbook a self-financing project for the school. KT's initiative in organizing fundraising activities such as plays, social activities and T-shirts sales were integral to the producation of the FGS yearbook and a wonderful experience in organization, marketing and publishing for the students that she mobilized to work with her. Our deepest appreciation to KT and the Yearbook Committee for their efforts and commitment in producing the 1993-1994 FGS yearbook.

# 6. Discipline

New rules and regulations have been initiated at the School in order to enforce discipline and encourage healthy behaviour amongst students. The honor badges marked with the FGS emblem have provided an additional incentive for students to be at their best both inside and outside their classrooms.

These are some of the accomplishments that we feel proud of from the past year. It has been a successful year with little interruption as compared with previous years. Only at the time of the heinous Hebron massacre was the school interrupted for any length of time.

As for real driving element of the School, those who study and work in it, I would like to say to all who have dedicated themselves, teachers, students and administrative staff alike, how proud I am of them all. I extend my warmest wishes to those who will be leaving us and hope that those who remain will continue to work on keeping their high performance standards at the FGS.



# Declaration of Principles

On September 9th, Palestinian President Yasser Arafat reiterated the P.L.O.'s recognition of the state of Israel. This was followed one day later by a ceremony in which Israeli Prime Minister, Yitzhak Rabin, recognized the Palestinian Liberation Organization as the representative of the Palestinian people. These two gestures came at the end of fourteen months of secret negotiations which had been held between Israeli and P.L.O. officials in Norway.



On September 13th, Rabin and Arafat signed an agreement in Washington that began a process of limited autonomy for Palestinians living in Jericho and the Gaza Strip. Although it was considered to be a historic event and many people celebrated in the streets, there were also many people who were confused and worried about the meaning of the agreement. After watching months of open 'peace negotiations," it was confusing to hear that the agreement would come from a completely different set of talks. Also, although an agreement was signed, no one really knew what the agreement said. People felt hopeful, but also as though they would need to wait and see what would happen next.


Although the world seemed to think that peace had come to Palestine, the situation on the streets of Ramallah did not change dramatically. The biggest changes came in the form of longer opening hours for stores and the sight of Palestinian flags everywhere. People could buy T-shirts, keychains and many other

things with flags on them. One day, a person could be killed for having a Palestinian flag, and the next day they were being sold everywhere. There were protests for the agreement and protests against the agreement. It was exciting, but also confusing and scary.



"After the agreement was signed and there were still problems in Ramallah, I felt that they had cheated us. The agreement was about peace, but there is no peace. They are still killing people. And the Palestinians have started to kill and kidnap Israelis. It is a war, because in the end everybody will be hurt. On the day of the agreement, everybody was happy. But after the agreement, the fighting began. Many people were hurt and killed by the soldiers of Israel.

On the morning of Friday, February 25th, the 15th day of the month of Ramadan, an Israeli went into the Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron (Al Khalil) and began to shoot the people who were doing their morning prayers. Because the people were not expecting an attack in a holy place, many were killed and even more were injured.


After that day, there were curfews all over Palestine. In Hebron, the curfews were even stronger. Neighboring countries such as Jordan offered medical aid and money for the families of those killed.

The massacre affected all Palestinians. It made us all think about our bad situation. Every day one or more of us is killed. We worry that there could always be another massacre in which we will be killed without having done anything.




# The New Autonomous Areas in Jericho and Gaza

People filled the roads, gardens and parks. Everybody enjoyed peace and freedom."
