MISSION and VISION STATEMENT

The Friends School of Ramallah and El-Bireh strives to be a leading educational institution in the Palestinian community. The Lower School (FGS) and the Upper School (FBS) were founded in 1869 and 1901 respectively, for the purpose of offering Palestinian youth a rigorous program guided by principles of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers). Central to Quaker education is a vitality which comes from being a living expression of a religious life. A Friends School education seeks to promote a constant search for God to all human situations, and to cultivate ethical, moral and spiritual values.

The Friends School is committed to

Excellence in education.

Quaker education calls for high academic standards and a willingness to experiment with new methodology and curricula.

Developing the whole person.

Quaker education is committed to helping each member of the school community realize his or her physical, mental, spiritual, and social potential. It recognizes that every person is different, with varying abilities which must be developed to the full extent possible.

Helping each person recognize her or his responsibility to society.

Quaker education is committed to helping each person recognize her or his responsibility as a caring member of the school, community, nation and global family where «each lives for the other and all live for God.» The Friends School is committed to nurturing character traits such as integrity, simplicity, honesty, cooperation and compassion. The School believes in and encourages freedom of thought and expression. They expect, however, that this freedom be enjoyed with a full sense of responsibility. Quaker education advocates non-violence as a viable option for resolving conflict in every aspect of life. These values are best learned through the example and practice as students, teachers, parents, workers and administrators interact with each other.

Equality.

Quaker education believes that all people are equal before God regardless of gender, creed, culture, color or social status. Quaker education in Palestine has focused from the beginning on the education of women to develop their potential and realize their opportunity to be equal members of their community. Quaker education is built on the belief that "all are children of God" and that within each person "there is that of God to be nurtured."

It is upon this foundation that Friends Schools' students grow to be strong and sensitive members of their families, their community and the world in which they live.

School Values

Truth: To be honest and truthful in all that we say and do.

Simplicity: To live simply is not to buy what we do not need or cannot afford. This challenge is based on the principle of leading of a life free of unnecessary luxury. This relates to the proper stewardships of the world's resources, conserving those resources, valuing them and using them when required and only necessary.

Peace: To fully maintain our witness that war and the seeds of war are inconsistent with our understanding of the love of God. To acknowledge in our lives those emotions, attitudes and prejudices which lie at the roots of destructive conflict.

Equality: To behave towards others as we would expect others to behave toward us.

Tolerance: To respect the diversity among us in our lives and relationships. We should not be afraid of disagreement and should not let any disagreement cause us to behave badly toward another but accept it as an example of our diversity.

Service: To take the fullest opportunity as it arises for the use of our gifts in the service of God and the community. We should be guided by God's will for us and attend to what love requires of us.

Creativity: To live our lives in such a way that we are open to inspiration and new ideas which challenge the way we think and act. There is inspiration to be found all around us in the natural world, in the sciences and the arts, in our work and our friendships, and in our sorrows as well as our joys. We should also approach all new ideas with discernment seeking to enrich and understand our lives together in all that we do.

Discipline: To be disciplined and respectful in our behavior towards others and in the exercise of our responsibility toward our family and community. To respect our bodies knowing that we are God's creation.

Justice: We seek to promote a sense of belonging and group responsibility particularly when disruptive behavior in the classroom, corridors or playground occurs or when behavior that damages good relationships between people needs correction.

We took risks, we were action oriented, and we remained determined to achieve our goals. Impossibility was deleted from our language and thinking, even in the face of many challenges.

Many were our achievements this year. In September, we started with a wonderful back to school party that our students and their parents enjoyed. We had several unit celebrations where our students shared their learning with their parents. Our students paid several visits to many of the community institutions as part of our community service program. In addition, and for the first time ever, our Kindergarten students with their parents joined the elementary students and their parents in preparing and conducting the bake sales. These donations serve the White Gifts Program, which has become one of the school's traditions serving needy families before Christmas. This was followed with Christmas performances and decorations that all parents and students enjoyed.

Aiming at being a green school, we had an intentional focus on the environment this year which included specific projects. The school participated in an environmental project organized by the municipality with fourteen other schools. As a result, an environmental day was conducted and celebrated with the parents of sixth grade students who performed a wonderful play focusing on environmental issues. Students also displayed their imaginative projects, made completely from recycled, reused materials, for all to see and enjoy. A large piece of school land was set aside and dedicated to the creation of an organic garden. The Garden includes a plastic house made from recycled water bottles. Both were used as a learning space for students who participated in planting them with several kinds of vegetables. This all led to our school winning first place in the environmental competition with other schools.

The culmination of our successes was becoming the first PYP (Primary Years Program) candidate school in Palestine. This is no small achievement. As always, our school is a pioneer piloting new endeavors for the purpose of achieving quality education, serving in developing our community and creating stronger generations for the future.

Conclusively, this year can be marked as a year of growing change. Our fifth and sixth graders are going to the Upper School at the end of this school year to enjoy the new middle school next year. We hope that this transition will be a smooth one for our students and their teachers. We will surely miss you all.

Many thanks to all who helped in making this year a successful one for all. I would also like to express my gratitude for FUM, the Director, and the BOT for their trust in my capacities and assigning me the position of Principal of the Lower School.

Flipping through its colorful pages, never ceases to make me proud of the accomplishments of our students, teachers and administrators. From achieving PYP Candidacy to completing exciting MYP 10th grade personal projects to embarking on teaching IB Film – it has been a year to celebrate!

The school's governing body is privileged to see firsthand the good work and join the school community in celebration of hope and a brighter future. Nevertheless, the school administrators and board members are also on the receiving end of their challenges, grievances and aspirations.



This is the reality that comes with running a school – everybody strives for change as a sign of an unequivocal commitment for making personal and organizational dreams come true. Inevitably with that, come discussions, debates and difficult decisions to make. The outcomes, often following hours of exchanges, is not only an improved program but more importantly, a more harmonious, trusting and closely knit school community. New funds were secured to fund the school's development plans, the latest was a grant of \$700,000 from USAID/ASHA that will help us improve many facilities including the creation of a proper gym on campus as well as demonstrate our good stewardship towards the environment by installing photo-voltaic cells that will generate clean and alternative energy for our campus.

It is going to be a very busy summer for the school leadership as we prepare for yet another vibrant new year. In the meantime we would like to remind parents of doing their best to spend quality time reading for or with their young children and to encourage their older children to do some meaningful work over the summer. Perhaps joining the Go Palestine Summer camp or the “I know I Can” Summer Academy which are run by the school or any other service program will prove worthwhile. Have a great summer!

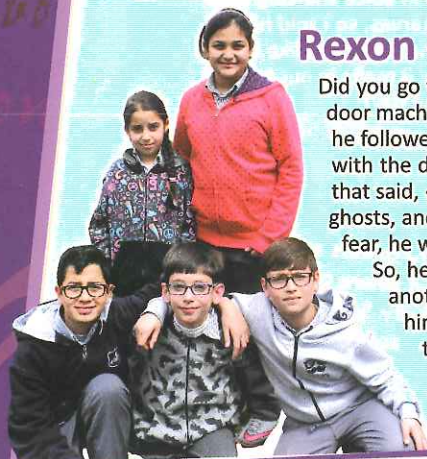


Rexon in the Wonderland

نشاطات المدرسة ضمن مشروع مدارس صحية وصديقة للبيئة

"The best time to plant a tree was 20 years ago. The next best time is today." – Chinese proverb

The FGS Environmental Club works to raise environmental and health awareness at the school. A small group of students established the club in 2010, with my support. This year, there are 35 members, from the 4th to 6th grades.

The club was inspired by the Ramallah Municipality's "Healthy and Environmentally-Friendly School" project, which encourages reclaiming agricultural land, rationalizing water and energy use, recycling and awareness raising.

The Environmental Club has brought this project to life. Our students reclaimed land by creating an organic garden in a neglected area of the school campus. Water use is rationalized through a drip irrigation system, and sixth graders built a greenhouse from recycled plastic bottles.

The garden allows our students to extend their learning beyond the classroom walls, as part of our PYP curriculum. Students reflect the PYP learner's profile as inquirers, communicators, principled, caring and knowledgeable. All work in the garden is done during classes, and students learn about the PYP themes of "Sharing our Globe" and "Where We Are in Place and Time."

Our students are demonstrating responsibility, respect, independency, enthusiasm and commitment. They plant, water, weed and care for the garden, which now has over 12 different vegetables. They are also now selling garden produce to teachers and parents, with proceeds going to buy more seeds and supplies.

On April 16th, the Environmental Club held an Environment Day at the school, as part of the municipality's competition for the most environmentally friendly and healthy school. After many hours of creativity and hard work, Friends Girls School placed first place in the city-wide competition where fourteen different schools participated. In addition, the students also won second place for the drama performance that focused on environmental issues. We are very proud!
